



### United States Tourism Industry

- √ \$1.9 trillion in tourism revenue
  in 2019, accounting for 2.9% of
  US GDP and creating a \$53.4
  billion trade surplus. Following
  the pandemic, the tourism
  industry quickly rebounded with
  GDP over \$23 billion (2.15% of
  total US GDP).
- ✓ The United States Department of Commerce is developing a plan to increase tourism; plans to welcome 90 million international visitors annually by 2027.





### **7.7% of the nation's tourism jobs** and only 1.7% of the US population.


#### Colorado Tourism Industry

- ✓ Welcomed 82.4 million visitors
  - ✓ Created 160k jobs
- ✓ Earned \$21.9 billion from direct travel spending.

#### Colorado Location Quotient

- Location quotients (LQ) are ratios that compare local employment to the United States average.
- If a LQ is above 1, it indicates an industry with a greater share of the local area employment than is the case nationwide.








## 6,609 people are employed in Grand County.






## The number of households is growing each year.






# The majority of visitors to Grand County come during summer months.


### Overall Tourism Map




# The diversity of activities throughout the county is abundant and widespread.




Granby had the highest visitor count in 2022.







